## How to talk with your landlord

DO	DON'T
✓ Put your requests in writing and keep a record of your communications.	Stay in the housing if your health is at risk. If you can, move to a smoke-free building.
✔ Be brief and clear about the problem and your proposed solutions. Be polite and business-like.	Confuse the issue by making other complaints at the same time.
Find out if other neighbors would like to live in a smoke-free building. Ask your landlord to conduct a survey.	Assume you're the only one who cares about this. Find others who are concerned to help you.
Let your landlord know about the business benefits of a no-smoking rule (high market demand, cheaper cleaning and maintenance, reduced liability.	Assume that your neighbors and landlord are aware of the problem.
Let your landlord know why they lost you as a tenant, if you choose to move.	Make threats or accusations.
